Athanasian Creed part 1

- P** Whoever will be saved shall, above all else, hold the catholic faith. Which faith, except everyone keeps whole and undefiled, without doubt he will perish eternally.
- C** **And the catholic faith is this, that we worship one God in three persons and three persons in one God, neither confusing the persons nor dividing the substance.**

Invocation

- P** In the name of the Father and of the ✠ Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C** **Amen.**
- P** Our help is in the name of the Lord,
- C** **who made heaven and earth.**
- P** If You, O Lord, kept a record of sins, O Lord, who could stand?
- C** **But with You there is forgiveness; therefore You are feared.**
- P** The Word of God teaches that we are all conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Christ claims us as His own. We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death and everlasting condemnation. Let us therefore, confess before God and one another that we have sinned in thought, word, and deed, and that we cannot free ourselves from our sinful condition and hold fast to Jesus Christ.

Silence for self-examination

- P** God, be merciful to me, a sinner. O almighty God,
- C** **Be merciful to me a sinner; have mercy upon us, forgive us our sins, and lead us to everlasting life. Amen.**

P But the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son Jesus Christ, who atoned for the sin of the whole world, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the ✠ Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C Amen.

Athanasian Creed *part 2*

P By faith we confess, the Father is uncreated, incomprehensible, eternal.

Men: The Son is uncreated, incomprehensible, eternal.

Women: The Spirit is uncreated, incomprehensible, eternal.

P So likewise the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, and the Holy Spirit is almighty.

C And yet they are not three almighties but one almighty.

P So the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God.

C And yet they are not three gods but one God.

P So likewise the Father is Lord, the Son Lord, and the Holy Spirit Lord.

C And yet they are not three Lords but one Lord.

P For we are compelled by the Christian truth to acknowledge every person of the Godhead by Himself to be both God and Lord,

Men: So we cannot by the catholic faith say that there are three Gods or three Lords.

¹⁵ “If you love me, you will keep my commandments. ¹⁶ And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever,¹⁷ even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.¹⁸ “I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you. ¹⁹ Yet a little while and the world will see me no more, but you will see me. Because I live, you also will live. ²⁰ In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. ²¹ Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. Athanasian Creed *part 3*

- P** God, the Father is made of none, neither created nor begotten. The Son is of the Father, not made nor created but begotten. The Holy Spirit is of the Father and of the Son, neither made nor created nor begotten but proceeding.
- C** **So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits. And in this Trinity none is before or after another; none is greater or less than another.**
- P** But the whole three persons are coeternal together and coequal,
- C** **So that in all things, as has been said, the Unity in Trinity and the Trinity in Unity is to be worshiped.**


Preface

- P** It is truly good, right, and salutary that we should at all times and in all places give thanks to You, holy Lord, almighty Father, everlasting God, who with Your only-begotten Son and the Holy Spirit called all things into being and now sustain all creation. Your triune majesty and the grandeur of creation humble us, Your fallen but forgiven creatures. Therefore with angels and archangels and with all the company of heaven we laud and magnify Your glorious name, evermore praising You and saying:

Heav'n and earth with full ac-claim shout the glo-ry of Your name.

P Blessed are You, O Lord our God, king of all creation, for You have had mercy on us and given Your only-begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

You once revealed Your name to Moses in the burning bush; and through Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, You unveiled the mystery of Your holy name in the Trinity of persons and the Unity of being.

Grant that we, who have been baptized and instructed in the triune name, may faithfully eat and drink of Your Son's body and blood and worship You in spirit and truth, O Father, through Your Son in the Holy Spirit.

Athanasian Creed *part 4*

- P** Furthermore, it is necessary to everlasting salvation that he also believe faithfully the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ. For the right faith is that we believe and confess that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is God and man.
- C** **God of the substance of the Father, begotten before the worlds; and man of the substance of His mother, born in the world; perfect God and perfect man, of a reasonable soul and human flesh subsisting.**
- P** Equal to the Father as touching His Godhead and inferior to the Father as touching His manhood; who, although He is God and man, yet He is not two but one Christ;
- C** **One, not by conversion of the Godhead into flesh but by taking the manhood into God; one altogether, not by confusion of substance but by unity**

of person.

P For as the reasonable soul and flesh is one man, so God and man is one Christ;

Men: Who suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose again the third day from the dead.

Women: He ascended into heaven, He sits at the right hand of the Father God Almighty, from whence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Men: At whose coming all men will rise again with their bodies and will give an account of their own works.

Women: And they that have done good will go into life everlasting; and they that have done evil, into everlasting fire.

P This is the catholic faith which, except a person believe faithfully and firmly, he cannot be saved.
