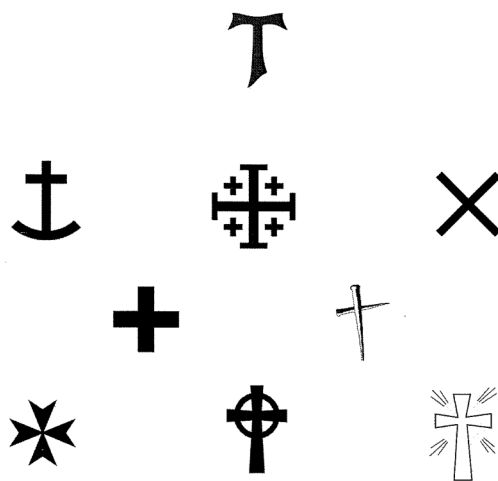

There is no more iconic image or centralized theme than the cross. No slogan or trademark, emblem or family crest has carried as much freight or had such a long-lasting and far reaching impact than the cross. In that one symbol stands a body of beliefs and a summated combination of one Man's life and One God's work.

The cross. The shape is simple, the meaning profound. And the centuries have melded meaning and purpose onto various iterations of that shape. From a scientifically designed Roman tool of slow pub-

lic humiliation, torture and death, to an anchor of hope, a sign of humility, a harbinger of new life, an emblem of mission and witness, the cross has become our gate to faith in Christ Jesus.

This Lent we dive deeper into the revelation of Christ's cross through other iterations of that symbol: the Tau cross, the Saltire cross, the Anchor cross, the Maltese Cross, the Greek cross, the Jerusalem cross (aka Crosslet cross), the Celtic Cross, the Passion Cross, and the Empty Cross. From Ash Wednesday through the Festival of the Resurrection of our Lord, we will swim through the arms of the cross and discover the blood of Christ that sets us free and gives us new life.

You know the cross. It's time to delve deeper. Join us every Wednesday in Lent at 6:00 PM, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter (cf. the schedule below). For your devotional development, we will be providing hand-made crosses of each type each week for whomever desires to have them in your home. They can become a symbol at your house, a witness of faith, an altar in your home, a reminder of the work of Christ and the faith you are given. We hope to have plenty for all interested. In a following newsletter, a brief description of the meaning of each and texts to follow will be shared.

Christ is the head, and around the neck of His body lays the cross, a witness and reminder, our Lord died, our Lord lives, we too are rising!

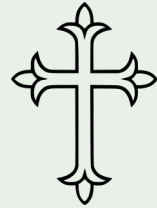

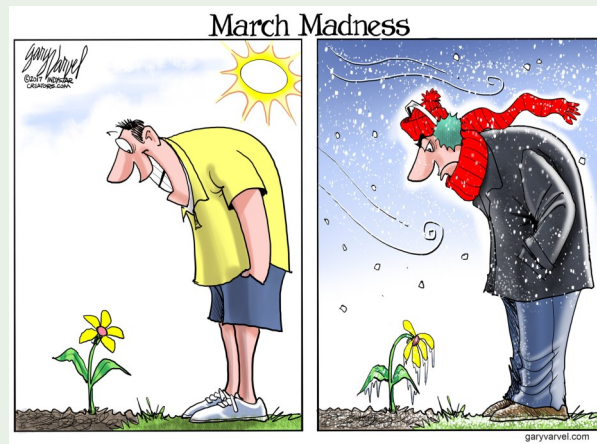

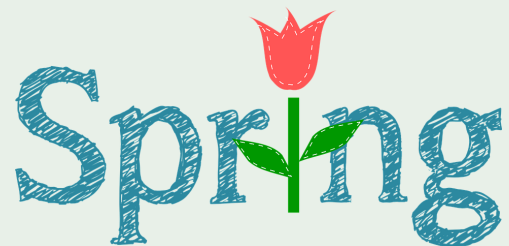
